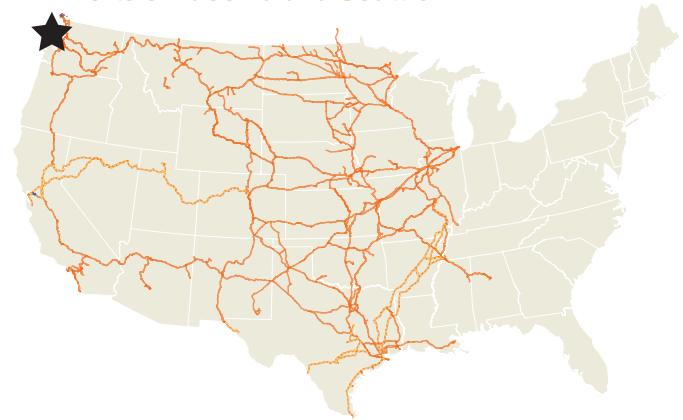


Located in the Pacific Northwest in Washington State, The Northwest Seaport Alliance (NWSA) is a marine cargo operating partnership of the ports of Tacoma and Seattle and is the fourth-largest container gateway for containerized cargo shipping between Asia and major distribution points in the Midwest, Ohio Valley and the East Coast. The NWSA handles more than 30 million tons of cargo annually with over 1900 vessel calls and is a major center for bulk, breakbulk, project/heavy-lift cargoes, automobiles and trucks.

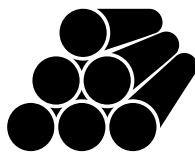
